

## Excel 2016 – Bubble Chart

A bubble chart is often used instead of a scatter chart when you have three series of values you wish to chart. The size of the bubbles is based on the values in the third data series.

For a bubble chart to be effective it should have at least three to four rows or columns of data.

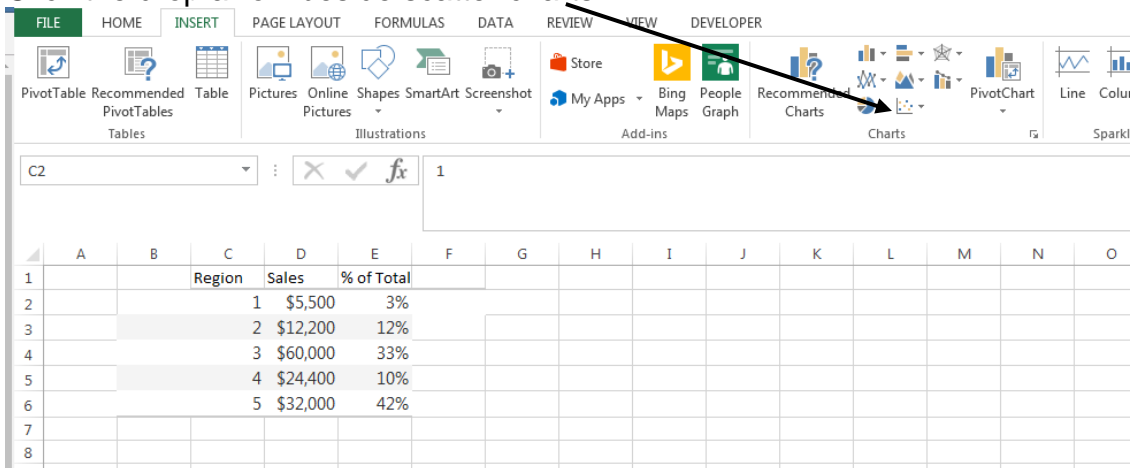
### To create a bubble chart

- Select the data you wish to chart – NOTE: Don't include any column or row headings

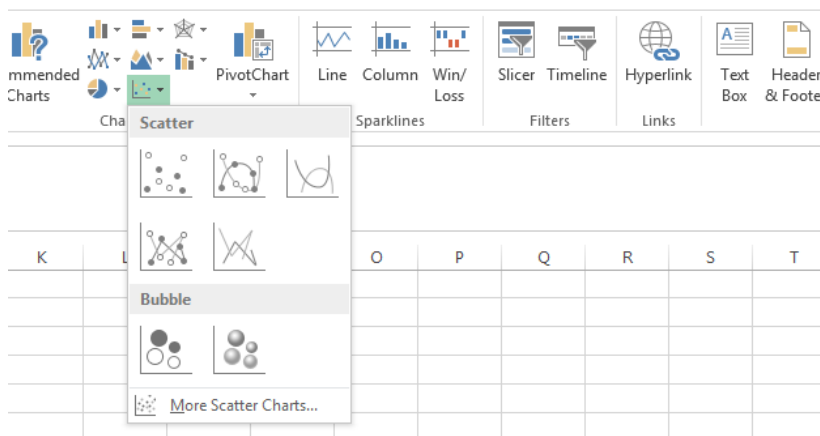

- Click the Insert tab

- Click the drop arrow beside scatter charts



- Choose desired bubble chart



- Edit as desired.
